



# REStud Tour

May 11 - 12, 2015

Federico II Conference Center – University of Naples Federico II

**General info on transportation:**

Naples Capodichino airport is located about 10 km from downtown, approx. 30 minutes by taxi or bus. The taxi stand is located outside Terminal 1. Alternatively you can call +39 081/5707070.

If you choose to catch a taxi, ask the driver to apply the fixed rate (EUR 23,00) from the airport to the hotel before boarding the vehicle.

Immediately outside Terminal 1 (where all incoming flights land) you will find the Alibus: this coach takes passengers to the center of Naples and stops at both Piazza Garibaldi (near Central Railway Station) and Piazza Municipio. Tickets are available on board at € 3.00.

If you land at Rome Fiumicino, then you should board the “Leonardo Express” that goes non-stop to the city center (Termini Train station). The ride is about 15 Euros. Alternatively you can ride a local train to a different station. Roma Ostiense and Roma Tiburtina are the largest ones. The ride is about 7-8 euros. A taxi ride is slightly shorter and costs 48 Euros including all extras. From Roma Termini station you can board a train to Naples. The high speed train (Frecciarossa) covers the distance in 70 minutes. You can buy tickets online (and save a few bucks) or directly at the vending machines. The regular fare is 43 euros, Economy class. In case you are delayed you can re-book your seat an infinite number of times before the train leaves and only once up to 60 minutes after the train left. If you buy in advance on Trenitalia’s website, you can find much cheaper tickets but beware that restrictions on rebookings apply. Alternatively you can leave from Roma Tiburtina with a high speed train operated by ITALO, a private company. The price and service are about the same. In peak hours there is more than a train every hour. Once in Naples, any taxi will bring you to the Hotel for about 10/15 Euros

**Conference venue:** Federico II Conference Center, Via Partenope 36, Naples

**Informal dinner:** An informal pizza dinner will take place at “Sorbillo-Lievito Madre al Mare” – Via Partenope, 1 - on Sunday, May 10 at 7.45pm. The pizzeria is located just 8 minutes walking distance from Hotel Vesuvio, as you can see from the map [here](#).

**Conference dinner:** Conference dinner will take place at the Restaurant “Palazzo Petrucci”- Piazza San Domenico Maggiore, 4 - on Monday, May 11 at 8.00pm.

Shuttle to dinner location will load promptly at 19:45PM from Hotel Vesuvio.

**Visit to the National Museum of Capodimonte and Naples:** On Tuesday afternoon we planned a guided tour to the National Museum of Capodimonte which houses paintings from the 13th to the 18th centuries and part of the magnificent Farnese collection of classical, mostly Roman, monumental sculpture, which survives here largely intact. Time permitting we will spend the rest of the afternoon sightseeing. If you have an afternoon (or an evening) flight, you should consider going back to Naples by Taxi or black car.
