General info on transportation:

Naples Capodichino airport is located about 10 km from downtown, approx. 30 minutes by taxi or bus. The taxi stand is located outside Terminal 1. Alternatively you can call +39 081/5707070.

If you choose to catch a taxi, ask the driver to apply the fixed rate from the airport to Naples Beverello docks before boarding the vehicle. To check the taxi fares visit Taxi rates.

Immediately outside Terminal 1 (where all incoming flights land) you will find the Alibus: this coach takes passengers to the center of Naples and stops at both Piazza Garibaldi (near Central Railway Station) and Piazza Municipio. Tickets are available on board at € 3.00.

If you land at Rome Fiumicino, then you should board the "Leonardo Express" that goes non-stop to the city center (Termini Train station). The ride is about 15 Euros. To get from Roma Termini to Napoli Centrale, Naples' main train station, you can rely on FRECCIAROSSA and ITALO trains: they take just over an hour and the connections are very frequent (they run almost every hour). Once in Naples, any taxi will bring you to Naples Beverello docks where you can take a ferry to Capri. Aliscafi and Traghetti's timetable is available at http://www.capritourism.com/en/ship-timetable. Times change frequently: thus, check times of crossings a couple of days before you travel. You don't need to book your ferry tickets: you can just show up and buy them at the dock.

How to get to Anacapri

The direct bus from Marina Grande to Anacapri departs approximately every hour, meaning that often you will be better off taking the funicular railway train which climbs uphill through lemon groves and drops you directly in the Piazzetta. The Marina Grande ticket office is not located at the entrance to the funicular, but at the end of the arrival pier to the right (facing land), near the high speed ferry ticket offices.

Public buses on the island are minibuses which carry about 10 passengers seated. During the summer months, they are almost always crowded and there are often long lines at the bus stops, though the routes run more frequently. A pleasant way to reach Anacapri is by taxi. All the taxis on the island are open-top and can fit up to seven passengers. If you are travelling with a small group, you will find that hiring a taxi is not more expensive than catching the public bus.

Conference dinner: Conference dinner will take place at the Restaurant "Lido del Faro"- Località Punta Carena, Anacapri - on **Tuesday, June 28** at 8.00pm.

The restaurant is located on the tip of the Punta Carena promontory, at the foot of the island's lighthouse. It can be reached from the center of Anacapri by local bus or by taxi.
