The workshop has three main objectives:

- I) Foster “interactions” between economic theory and empirical economics on the design of organisational structures, incentives and selection processes in private and public institutions.
- II) Contribute to the training of young researchers and graduate students from Italy by allowing them to present their research papers and interact with internationally renowned economists as well as with young economists with a particularly distinguished publication record.
- III) Stimulate the debate on the reform of organisations and incentive schemes in Italian public institutions.
